NEW SERIES STARTS JANUARY 7

Whenever you're about to set out on a journey, there are a number of preparatory steps you need to take. You first need to figure out where you are. You will also need to figure out where you're going and how you plan to get there. Another essential part of preparation is getting the family excited about the trip. Mount Lebanon is setting out to climb a mountain. Over the next four years, we are planning to imagine our mission together as a family climbing a mountain. This first year is all about knowing where we are, determining together more clearly what our destination is, and rallying the family about that direction.

As we begin this journey, we're going to start with a look at Nehemiah. Nehemiah is a fitting book for us to study. The year is approximately 445 BC. The first round of exiles returned from Babylon 93 years earlier. It's been a long time since they began their mission back in Jerusalem (just like it has been 90+ years since our mission began here). Yet, they hadn't finished their work. Yet. This is the story of Nehemiah and how he rallied the people of God around the mission God had given them.
