Life. So, what does this life in exile look like? How should we live? Should we try to get back home? Should we withdraw from the world and create our own little commune? Jeremiah wrote a letter to the exiles and directed them regarding their lives in Babylon. A look at Jeremiah 29:1, 4-14.

NEXT WEEK: Life in Babylon #3 - Fatherly

Attention. Israel has been given a deep wound because of their own rebellion. That's why they were in Babylon. But Jeremiah wants them to know that the Lord was not trying to get his pound of flesh out of him. This was discipline, discipling, not punishment. He was calling out to them as a father through the exile. Can we start to see our own waywardness as we live in the fallen world? Can we start to see how we have lived farther and farther from God's way? Can we sense the Lord's discipling hand in our life? "Our wound is incurable" (Jeremiah 30:12), but the LORD "will restore you to health" (Jeremiah 30:17). A look at Jeremiah 30:10-17.
