Life in Babylon

America is a land of immigrants. Most of our stories find their ancestral roots outside of this country where we find our home. At the same time, many of us call this place home. We're generally settled with foundations. But more and more, things around us are changing so that we don't recognize this country anymore. We could talk about moral standards. We could talk about faith traditions. Perhaps, in past days we could describe America as largely Christian. However, according to recent surveys, less than half of Americans would consider themselves Christians. How do we live in a country that feels less and less like home? What should we do? We're back to Jeremiah for one last jaunt in his prophecy and he has something to say to us about our life as exiles and aliens. The Israelites would be taken into exile in Babylon, and he had words for them. In the same way, he has words for us. Next week we'll be looking at Jeremiah 27:1-15.
